CIRCULAR

It is hereby informed that, on reconsideration, Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India has been pleased to modify the norms in the matter of pattern and scale for provision of uniform to the officers/employees as mentioned in the Circular No.Shirts/17/SCI(AM) dated 23rd February, 2018. The revised norms are as under :

(ii) Senior Court Assistants, Court Assistants and Junior Court Assistants and equivalent posts	MALE White Shirt	Three shirts for Summer and Two Shirts for Winter in three years	MALE Rs.1,000/- per Shirt
		FEMALE (i) Plain Suit/Suit with self design with Dupatta, or Saree with blouse, in overall white colour; (ii) Plain Suit/Suit with self design with Dupatta, or Saree with blouse, in overall black colour; or (iii) Plain Suit/Suit with self design with Dupatta, or Saree with blouse, in combination of black/white colours (iv)White Saree with black border and vice-versa (v)White Shirt and black/grey trouser (vi) Tie is optional and will be issued by Admn.Material Branch on an undertaking by the employee that she shall wear the Tie along with the Shirt. Notes : a) Self design on black / white colours fabric is permitted provided that the self design is of the same colour as that of the base fabric. b) Fabric with small print [not more than one inch size] in black and white combination is also permitted. c) The newly married female staff will be exempted from wearing white/black uniform for a period of six months from the date of marriage.	Three sets for summer and two sets for winter in three years	FEMALE Rs.1200/- per suit with Dupatta or Saree with blouse or Trouser/shirt

Except for exemption for newly married female staff for six months, all the officers and employees shall wear the prescribed uniform at all times while on duty and there shall be no exemption from wearing uniform on Saturdays and during vacations.

It is however clarified that the norms for uniform which existed prior to Circular No.Shirts/17/SCI(AM) dated 23rd February, 2018 remain unchanged and they shall also be adhered to in addition to the revised norms.

The revised directions shall come into force with effect from 2nd April, 2018.
